Motion, seconded, all in favor. Passed.

7:40 Vice Chancellor Presentation on CUP

- Vice Chancellor Waitz, Chair of the CUP Prof. Bahr, and Kate Weishaar
- Improving the first year experience by allowing for exploration
- Looking at the available data to see the program's impact
 - Increased opportunity to explore
 - One fewer science core GIR taken
 - Mostly a delay in biology or chemistry
 - o Decrease in major related stress but not more prepared to choose
 - No change in overall GPA but some decreases in core GIR grades
 - o Increase in HASS GIR grades
 - Changes in GPA is statistically significant
 - Suggests a redistribution of effort
 - Most change in 8.02
- Want more discovery opportunity for those coming in without prior AP/ASE credit
- Students enjoy the flexibility of the policy
- Proposal of Flexible P/NR Grading
 - 4 subjects PNR after first semester with ability to retroactively change grading
 - Replaces some later exploration opportunities
 - o Streamline the undergraduate options
- Several concerns
 - Not dropping a class that they [students] should

8:30 Career Exploration Committee Report Recommendations

- Prof. Darmofal
- How to do better when it comes to student career exploration
- Peers are often the number one source of career information, others vary by year and education level
- Often less opportunity to explore for science majors
 - Those going to grad school often less happy with career exploration opportunities
- Women typically with less opportunity, variation by department
 - Unconfounding that variable with variability in department/school
- Reset career timeline
 - Pushback career fair to late october
 - Automatic extension for applying to grad school (April 15)
 - o push back offer deadlines to 4 months before start
- Mini opportunities to prototype careers/career exploration conference
- Expand UROP exposure at career fairs
- Increased funding for research/nonprofit work
- Career fair profit used to fund further exploration opportunities
- Career Fair directors work for CAPD, creates better integration of the two entities and a better fair overall
