- Danielle asks council about potential for 6-7:30pm meetings (Laura R. and Sonia R. would need to miss the last 30 minutes)
- Albert S. wonders if we should be voting on biweekly meetings peremptorily or calling them on

- Last year there were 12 council meetings and this year there have already been 12 council meetings
- Sarah E. says she trusts Danielle's judgement, but would be okay with shorter more frequent meetings
- Yara feels that there have been a large number of emergency councils, so biweekly meetings may be something to consider. Sonia R. agrees.

- Kevin W., as the UA treasurer, gives an overview of the budget that was approved by the special budget committee for the UA

- SOL recommended that the UA ask for funds for the Fall as the plans for the spring are unknown
- 10 spreadsheets with each UA committee and their budgets (each spreadsheet total is linked to the composite budget

- Kevin continues to go through each line of the final budget is accessible at the above link
- Many cuts and reductions were a result of the proposal being only for the Fall or for things that are not necessary or as essential during a pandemic
- Nico S. asks if there is a tab for the Covid Committee
- Miana asks about the need for UA officer apparel budget
- Sarah E. asks for UA faculty student meetings (Kevin answers that the budget is for Grubhub/ubereats credit)
- Jaya K. asks what is MIT Omegle? Similar to regular site, but for MIT community
- Miana S. asks what happens to funds that are not spent. Kevin answers that if funds are not spent by committees they are absorbed back into SOL
- Danielle mentions UA bylaws stipulation that half of the funds leftover at the year would have to be saved in the UA reserves (and for non ASA committees)
- Nico S. asks about Career Fair budget from UA so SOL and UA worked together to wean UA off of the Career fair budget (this past year 40k out of 1.4M was from the career fair)
- Kate N. has a question about the difference between the social budget bonding and the food credit social event
- Yu Jing adds that the social budget doesn't include food and social events like escape rooms have cost money in the past
