#### <u>6:25 PM Discussion Topics</u>

- First Year Integration
  - Many feeling disconnected to campus despite friends in classes
  - o Zoom exhausting and hard to mimic spontaneity of friendships in real life
  - Lots of people hanging out with highschool friends
  - Excitement around them being on campus in the spring
  - Academic concern and feeling alone in their struggles-- isolating
  - o Panhel just finished recruitment cycle
  - Game nights and informal rush events for IFC
  - Seniors apathetic to welcoming first years because will never be on campus together
  - SCUFFY in maseeh 18 first years to 6 or so upperclassmen, Next house closer to 1:1 ratio (finding times to meet is difficult), random attempting to match up people more organically via discord
  - Academically
    - 14.01: Watch last year's videos, super strange
    - Other classes doing that too 6.042 and UAD and 6.849
    - 6.042 have lectures over the weekend
    - 15.401 11.01 Requiring everyone to have videos on
    - 4 units of inclass time listed but none of the recitations aren't necessary but get information there which makes it 5 hours
      - Flexibility bc people are struggling outside of academics

#### Research

- Building status is difficult to manage, getting kicked out of COVID Pass access if you don't do lab training etc.
  - Can't build a habit of doing attestation at a certain time if 24 hour window (easier when 25 hours)
  - Some people get notifications go to phones or emails but others don't
  - App over notifies you so not useful/hard to tell when it is important
  - Overall need to streamline notification
- o Really slow to VPN into MIT's network if off campus
- Compliance and Testing
  - o Reif passionate about having everyone on campus in spring
  - How to encourage continued to compliance
  - Weather will make things harder in the spring
    - Include off campus in covid testing plan? Because people may visit friends off campus indoors instead of outdoors
    - Likely a need for stringent cases regardless
  - Need to have fun things for people to do safely and socially distanced on campus (bored and nothing to do on weekends)
  - Still in early process of spring planning
  - Increased sensitivity around student needs nearing election day

#### Additional notes:

- Administrators' desired feedback
  - First-year inclusion
    - i. (From Maximilian P.) Freshmen are feeling disconnected from campus
    - ii. (From Meghana V.) Exhaustion from limited social interaction on Zoom
    - iii. (Sam D.) Isolation while struggling with classes, lack of academic community
    - iv. (Nico S.) Informal game nights, watch parties, etc.
    - v. (Sarah E.) Seniors don't have motivation to engage with first-years
  - Research
    - i. (Nico S. & Miana S.) Student researchers randomly locked out of buildings

#### o Spring 2021

- i. (Sam D.) Considering cross-school interactions, especially indoors
- ii. (Jaya K.) Suggests that restrictions and social distancing policies will not relax
- iii. (Sarah E.) Creating a routine around attestation which expires every 24
- iv. (Sarah E. & Sam D.) Obnoxious app notifications, isn't helpful to maintain compliance
- v. (Sarah E.) Accessing resources to hold safe, fun, socially-distanced events; engaging with people not in your pod
- vi. (Several councilmembers) ensuring faster communication about the final decisions on the Spring semester
- vii. (Meghana V.) Increased sensitivity around election-time
