# 8:05 Task Force 2021

- Rick Danheiser and Lisa Schwaille join use for a conversation about Task Force 2021
  - o Rick and Sanjay Sarma chair the task force

- o Thought of in May, kicked-off in June
- Rationale for Task Force
  - o Impact of the pandemic for 2021 and beyond, the post-COVID world
  - o Heightened concerns over social injustice
  - o Taskforce website: https://tf2021.mit.edu/
- Four workstreams
  - Academic
  - Administrative
  - Finance and Data
  - Community and Culture
- Working groups under the workstreams
  - o 180+ people total working on this effort
  - o Around 20 students
  - Mostly admin and staff
- Phases
  - o Phase 1: Working groups generate ideas (Early summer to late fall)
  - o Review until Early Spring
  - Phase 2: Refinement and implementation planning committees (RICs) until late spring
    - Consolidate ideas when needed
    - Develop a plan for implementation transfer responsibility to existing offices/personnel or create ad-hoc committees
    - RICs are ~50% phase 1 team, ~50% decision-makers on implementation side
    - 16+ RICs including:
      - Undergraduate program
      - Social responsibility
      - Graduate student professional development
      - Graduate student advising and mentoring
      - Undergraduate experience: Advising, mentoring, and development
      - Under-recovery commission
  - o Finalization until early summer
  - o Finally, implementation

#### 9:23 PM Divest

- Overview of Fossil Fuel Divestment by MIT Divest
  - Removal of investments and holdings in the fossil fuel industry. Why?
    - Inconsistency with sustainable future
    - Anti-science and anti-democratic practices by these companies
      - Environmental justice
      - Climate disinformaiton
      - Anti-climate lobbying
  - Divestment
    - Increases pressure on government and these companies to change
    - Invest in our future while supporting our endowment
    - MIT setting an example, would be the first technical institute to do so
      - Currently behind its peers on this
  - Common argument against divestment
    - Engagement works
      - Engaging with these industries helps move things forward
      - But, these efforts have failed to effectively transition these companies
    - Logistically impossible
      - Commingled funds
      - Feels like a cop-out as other institutions with similar structures
- All 8 ivy league and 10 big ten schools support it (via their student governments)
  - UA sustain survey shows that undergrads largely support this
- Divest asks to MIT administration
  - Disclose their relationships, divest from fossil fuels, and reinvest in fossil free industries
- Asks to UA council
  - Endorsement of Divest petition
