- Divest proposes a <u>resolution</u> for councilors to vote on
  - o Sustain will be sharing an infographic for councilors to share with constituents

- Q&A

  - WHo would be making divestment actions
    - Likely MITIMCO, Cambridge Associates, or other financial arms of MIT
  - Next steps
    - Divest would be to publicize the UA Council decision to help apply pressure to administration and bring our petition to the admin with the full support of the UA
    - Divest and the UA could work together in some regard, in perhaps increasing visibility of the resolution's asks

- Coordinated by UA education
- Three section petition

    - Make sure that all classes give five week flags
    - Make sure largely weighted assignments/tests/grades are contextualized (A, B, C, etc. cutoffs are clear, how students stand relative to class expectations)
    - Make sure that student can be provided justification for any and all grades
- Would like to gauge constituents opinions before April 10 when it will be presented to faculty

#### 8:20 PM Student Support

- Student support and wellness are very important during this challenging time of the semester and everything going on nationally
  - Especially for first years who may be having their first semester on campus
- How can we better support students
  - Letter going out from administrators and the UA soon
  - o MIT confessions have been very dark lately
  - o No spring break or real breaks to look forward to
    - Lots of burnout
    - Could include a buffer between four day weekends and having assignments due
    - Does a typical spring break actually feel like a break? For some people more than others.
  - Professors also under a lot of pressure to condense their classes into a shorter semester
  - Outside world can also serve as nonstop stressor
